Soil and bedrock depths vary depending on your location. Bedrock wells are typically 6 to 8 inches in diameter, structured by three components: well casing, bedrock, and water bearing fractures. Well casing supports the upper portion of the well and protects the well from harsh elements found in ground surface and soil. The layer of bedrock in the Earth's crust allows water to pocket and flow through factures, providing water to your well.



Geothermal exchange is a method which utilizes the Earth's natural ground temperature for heating and cooling your home or business. Outdoor temperatures fluctuate season-to-season, but four to six feet below earth's surface, the temperature remains relatively consistent year-round. During

cooler weather, heat is absorbed from the earth and transferred into the building through water or water solution. Indoors, energy from the heat pump exchange raises the temperatures and distributes throughout the home. For cooling, the process is reversed. Heat is absorbed from the building and transferred back into the earth. Geothermal heating and cooling provides the opportunity to save money, energy, and the environment.


